

## Deeper Still...

Our goal is to know God, so we can worship Him. When one of God's names is given in the Bible, it is a way God demonstrates and show Himself to us. In ancient cultures, to know someone's name, was to *know* them. It was an intimate exchange.

Cultivate a habit at the end of everyday to think about what you can praise God for, then worship God for the name that corresponds to what you can praise Him. Use your own list of Names of God, or refer to the partial list provided for you.

For example:

I praise God because I felt His presence when feelings of grief overwhelmed me today. I worship God because He is Elohay Kol Hanechamah, the Great Comforter, and the One who comforts me.

This habit cultivates the fruit Hebrews 13:15 says, Therefore let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise – ***the fruit of lips that openly profess his name***. This means when you go through times when your mind is under attack and you can't recall anything the Lord has done for you, you will have a record to help you remember.
